The greens and grounds that may have suffered some damage are healing nicely and full recovery of those areas is expected. Please treat our golf carts with respect, as they are a huge capital investment for all Elks members.

A special welcome is extended to our new first-time members. Some helpful reminders for all. Remember, we are all member/owners of a private Lodge, which gives us special privileges to a great facility. Therefore, it is important to observe our stated policies on proper dress attire along with course etiquette. The current dress code follows the standard policies of most private courses and applies to all members and any guests: For Men: Shirts tailored for golf e.g. turtlenecks, mock, and collared, are all permitted. No muscle shirts, tee shirts, sweat pants or cut offs will be allowed on the premises. For Women: Clothes tailored for golf are permitted. No cut offs, tank tops, sweat pants or tees.
