41st Annual Blood Drive - Tuesday, August 16, 2022 - Noon - 5:45pm

Our 39th consecutive Blood drive was on June 20th. We had (3) first time donors, (34) donors registered with (6) donors deferred and (25) whole blood pints collected (2 Power reds = 4 pints) for 29 total units which were collected which is 87% of our goal. We also had 11 Type "O" donors of the 34 who arrived to provide the "Gift of Life". With Lodge 343 supporting the American Red Cross, we have collected over 1,304 units (pints) = 163 plus gallons of blood since our 1st blood drive on January 7, 2013. We are now on our way to reaching our next goal of 2,000 pints (250 gallons). Thank you to Mary from the Burchville Lions Club who donated her time at the sign in table and step-down area.

These Veterans represent the St. Clair County American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW), and Disabled American Veterans (DAV) posts. These Veterans engage in multiple ceremonies in St. Clair County, such as, Veterans Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, visiting retirement homes, and nursing facilities. The St. Clair County Allied Veterans Honor Guard averages over 250 military funeral ceremonies per year in St. Clair County. This Honor Guard unit is a certified Volunteer Service Organization for Great Lakes National Cemetery in Holly, Michigan, where once a month they perform up to ten military funeral services per day for service men and women. It's a privilege for the Port Huron Elks Lodge 343 to honor these men and women for their service.

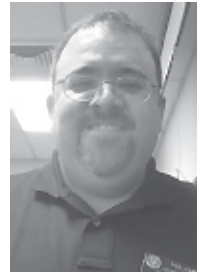

VETERANS CORNER #19 - U.S. NATIONAL GUARD

In last month's Veterans Corner article #18 we discussed the United States Coast Guard (USCG) this month we cover the United States National Guard.

The United States National Guard is part of the reserve components of the United States Army and the United States Air Force. It is a military reserve force composed of National Guard military members or units of each state and the territories of Guam, the Virgin Islands, Puerto Rico, and the District of Columbia, for a total of 54 separate organizations. All members of the National Guard of the United States are also members of the organized militia of the United States as defined by 10 U.S.C. § 246. National Guard units are under the dual control of the state governments and the federal government. The majority of National Guard soldiers and airmen hold a civilian job full-time while serving part-time as a National Guard member. These part-time guardsmen are augmented by a full-time cadre of Active Guard & Reserve (AGR) personnel in both the Army National Guard and Air National Guard, plus Army Reserve Technicians in the Army National Guard and Air Reserve Technicians (ART) in the Air National Guard. The National Guard is a joint activity of the United States Department of Defense (DoD) composed of reserve components of the United States Army and the United States Air Force: the Army National Guard and the Air National Guard, respectively. Local militias were formed from the earliest English colonization of the Americas in 1607. The first colony-wide militia was formed by Massachusetts in 1636 by merging small older local units, and several National Guard units can be traced back to this militia. The various colonial militias became state militias when the United States became independent. The title "National Guard" was used in 1824 by some New York State militia units, named after the French National Guard in honor of the Marquis de Lafayette. "National Guard" became a standard nationwide militia title in 1903, and specifically indicated reserve forces under mixed state and federal control since 1933. The English Colonial Militia was founded on December 13, 1636 over 385 years ago, and reformed as the National Guard since 1824, originally in New York and then nationwide since 1903, over 128 years ago. Then to its current service as the dual state-federal reserve forces known as the National Guard since 1933, over 88 years ago.
